Dear Community Stakeholder:

To support ADA accessibility improvements at Queensboro Plaza **Manhattan-bound 7/N/W trains will be bypassing Queensboro Plaza 24 hours/day beginning Monday, July 31st at 5am for N-train, and 6 am for 7/W - trains. These will continue through Monday, August 14th with all planned service changes ending at approximately 5:00 am.**

- **Manhattan-bound customers seeking service at Queensborough Plaza, who have not yet paid a fare and entered the system are encouraged to use the nearby Queens Plaza Station (E/M/R) to avoid back-riding. Queens Plaza will have service in both directions during this time.**
- **Customers may also back-ride using either a Flushing-bound 7 train to 33rd Street-Rawson or an Astoria-bound N/W train to 39th Avenue to switch to Manhattan-bound service.**

We will be sending out additional reminders closer to the planned change with digital assets that can be shared, as well as a press release.
