Community Board 2 would like to thank you and your team for taking the time to meet with Community Board 2, Council Member Won's Office and CB 2 community members on July 10, 2024.

Queens Community Board 2 is writing to request a traffic study on 39th Road between Woodside Avenue and 52nd Street.

Members of the community noted that since the redesign of 39th Ave., 39th Rd. has seen an increase in automobile traffic, and with that an increase in illegal speeding and unsafe turns at crosswalks.

This small, narrow road in a residential neighborhood is placed between a large apartment building and a city park and its street corners and crosswalks serve large numbers of pedestrians traveling to the many schools, parks, and businesses in the neighborhood.

CB 2's Transportation Committee respectfully requests the New York City Department of Transportation conduct a traffic study of this location, which we believe, may result in improvements in design for safe crossings as well as a reduction in automobile speeds and traffic volume.
