



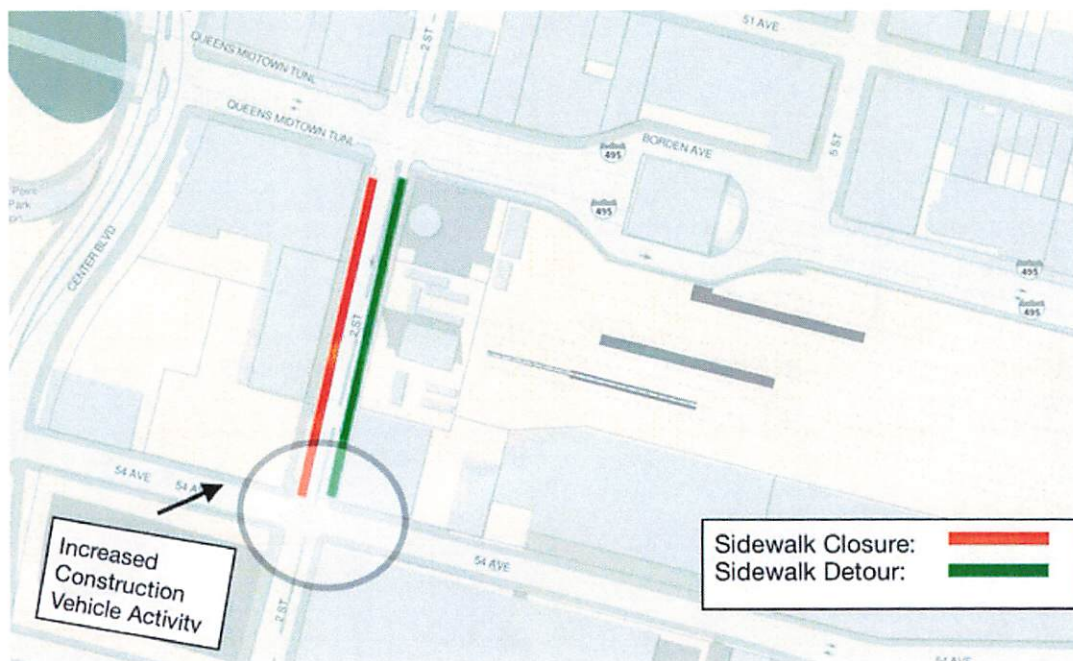
EAST RIVER TUNNEL REHABILITATION PROJECT

New Construction Activities

To advance the ERT Project, a series of concrete pours will take place over the next three months along 2nd Street, between Borden Avenue and 54th Avenue, in front of the Amtrak Long Island City Vent Shaft Building. The western sidewalk on 2nd Street will be closed, and flaggers will be in place to direct pedestrian traffic. This work will take place between 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. These activities may result in increased noise and construction traffic in the area. One lane will remain open for vehicular traffic on 2nd Street. Please expect delays and plan for additional travel time. We apologize for any inconvenience and appreciate your understanding.



The East River Tunnel (ERT) consists of four tubes connecting New York City to destinations east. The ERT Rehabilitation Project will restore the two tubes that were damaged by Superstorm Sandy.
