



Long Island City Neighborhood Plan Hybrid Land Use Public Hearing

Join us live or via Zoom as Borough President Donovan Richards hosts a hybrid land use public hearing on the OneLIC Long Island City Neighborhood Plan.

Borough President Richards will hear a presentation from the NYC Department of City Planning on the plan's proposed zoning map and text amendments, Urban Development Action Area Project actions, City-owned property dispositions and City map changes. Following the presentation, members of the public will be allowed to offer testimony on the plan.
