Dear Commissioner Garcia:

At the April 7, 2025, meeting of the Transportation Committee, a motion was made and seconded to request DOT conduct a Feasibility Study at the 61st Street, Woodside Station for Bicycle Safety Infrastructure and Bicycle Parking, Improved Lighting and Improved Sidewalks and waiting area for Q70 LaGuardia Link & Q53 SBS, as it is the gateway to NYC for people coming from LaGuardia. Currently, there is inadequate infrastructure for people on foot and for those who bike to access a major transit hub.

All were in favor of the motion with none opposed and no abstentions.

Community Board 2 is respectfully requesting the NYC Department of Transportation conduct a feasibility study at the noted location in order to improve the overall safety of the public.
