## A Word from the District Manager ...

*The virus COVID-19 (Coronavirus) can be spread from person to person usually through respiratory droplets. If someone with the virus coughs or sneezes and another person is close by and breathes it in, this is how it can spread. It has been suggested to have at least 6ft between persons. And to have group gatherings of no larger than ten. The symptoms may appear in as few as two days, or fourteen days after exposure. There is currently no vaccine to prevent the COVID-19 illness. The best way to prevent infection is to avoid being exposed through human contact, wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, and avoid close contact with people who are sick. Stay home when you are sick. Wearing a mask is not going to prevent you from getting somebody else's germs. The mask works to prevent other people from getting sick if you are sick.*

## NYC Department of Sanitation

The City's Alternate Side Parking fine change has gone into effect. The new Rule will make Alternate Side Parking fines uniform across the entire city at \$65. Prior it was \$45, however, in Manhattan below 96 Street it was \$65. The change will increase the effectiveness of the City's Alternate Side Parking regulations and help to keep NYC healthy, safe and clean. Invitations for the 2020 Census are currently being mailed out. The Census Bureau is using the internet to securely collect your information. Responding online helps conserve natural resources, save taxpayer money, and process data more efficiently. If you are unable to complete your 2020 Census questionnaire online, a paper questionnaire can be mailed for you to complete. Results from the 2020 Census will be used to:

- Direct billions of dollars in federal funds to local communities for schools, road, and other public services
- Help your community prepare to meet transportation and emergency readiness needs.
- Determine the number of seats each state has in the US House of Representatives and your political presentation at all levels of government.
