



Programs and Resources Available Through the CI&R System

The Coordinated Intake and Referral (CI&R) system screens and refers eligible pregnant and parenting families of young children (up to 4 years old).

Newborn Home Visiting Program	Provides virtual or in-person visits to families with an infant up to 3 months old to support them with infant feeding, share health and safety tips, and connect them to services.
Nurse-Family Partnership	Provides nurse home visits to first-time pregnant families with low income starting at or before 28 weeks of pregnancy and lasting until the child is 2 years old.
Healthy Families NY	Provides home-based services to expectant families and new parents, beginning before or shortly after the birth of the child and lasting until the child enters school or a Head Start program.
Power of Two	Provides support to the main caregiver, parent, or foster parent of a child 2 to 48 months old to help develop the responsive parenting skills needed to set the child up for success.
Citywide Doula Initiative	Provides nonmedical support before, during, and after childbirth to pregnant people and their families who are income-eligible for Medicaid and live in a TRIE ZIP code, shelter, or foster home.
