RE: Request for a Feasibility Study at the Complex Intersection of 44th Street, Greenpoint Avenue and 48th Avenue

Dear Commissioner Garcia:

At the April 7, 2025, meeting of the Transportation Committee, a motion was made and seconded to request DOT conduct a Feasibility Study at the complex intersection of 44th Street, Greenpoint Avenue and 48th Avenue.

In consideration of the conflicts between people on foot or bicycle and motor vehicles due to the multi-stage pedestrian crossings and nearby supermarket, school and dense housing. CB 2 is requesting consideration for safety countermeasures such as a mini-roundabout or Barnes dance (i.e. all-direction pedestrian crossing).

All were in favor of the motion with none opposed and no abstentions.

Community Board 2 is respectfully requesting the NYC Department of Transportation conduct a feasibility study at the noted location in order to improve the overall safety of the public.
