At the April 7, 2025, meeting of the Transportation Committee, a motion was made and seconded to request DOT conduct a Feasibility Study at the complex intersection of 44<sup>th</sup> Street, Greenpoint Avenue and 48<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

In consideration of the conflicts between people on foot or bicycle and motor vehicles due to the multi-stage pedestrian crossings and nearby supermarket, school and dense housing. CB 2 is requesting consideration for safety countermeasures such as a mini-roundabout or Barnes dance (i.e. all-direction pedestrian crossing).

All were in favor of the motion with none opposed and no abstentions.

Community Board 2 is respectfully requesting the NYC Department of Transportation conduct a feasibility study at the noted location in order to improve the overall safety of the public.
