**PAVEMENT MILLING AND PAVING
BROOKLYN QUEENS EXPRESSWAY
FROM 58th STREET TO 70th STREET
IN QUEENS**

10:00 PM EACH WEEKNIGHT TO 5:00 AM EACH MORNING

The New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) is advising the public there will be nighttime pavement milling and asphalt paving operations on the westbound and eastbound Brooklyn Queens Expressway (BQE) from 58th Street to 70th Street in Queens. There will be overnight mainline BQE lane closures and the entrance and exit ramps to and from Laurel Hill Boulevard 58th Street, 66th Street and Queens Boulevard will be partially closed at times to facilitate the operations. Work will commence on or about Friday night, August 5th at 10:00 p.m. and continue each weeknight through approximately Saturday morning August 13th, at 5:00 a.m.

Inclement weather may delay the scheduled operations. This work is part of NYSDOT's pavement preservation project that is taking place in Queens, Kings, and Richmond Counties.
