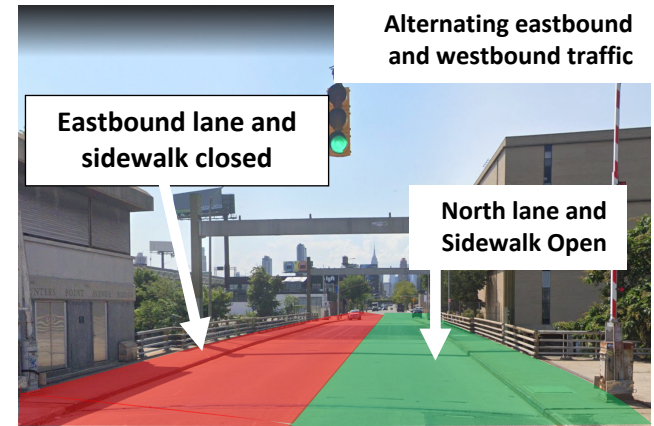
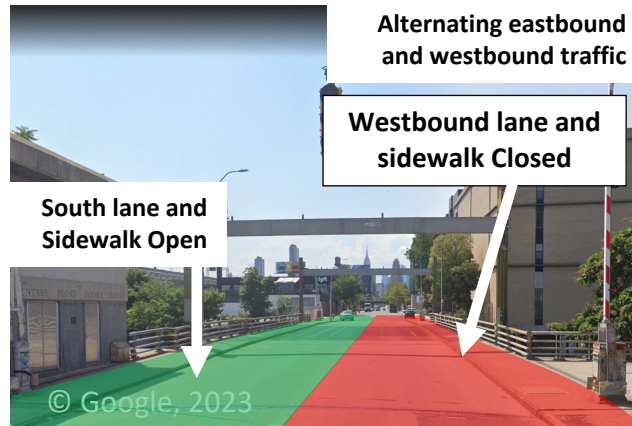

Important Notice

The NYCDOT Division of Bridges is mobilizing on the **Hunters Point Avenue Bridge over Dutch Kills** in Queens as a part of the lead paint removal and repainting project. **Beginning on Wednesday, May 29th** Hunters Point Avenue Bridge (between 27th Street and 29th Street) will be **reduced to one travel lane in each direction during work hours with the active work area sidewalk also closed.**

Monday through Friday: 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. & Saturday and Sunday: 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Motorists may choose to travel via Borden Avenue as an alternate. **This traffic pattern will be in place for approximately 12 weeks.**

Noise and air monitoring is in place. Paint removal operations are scheduled intermittently over the 12 weeks.
