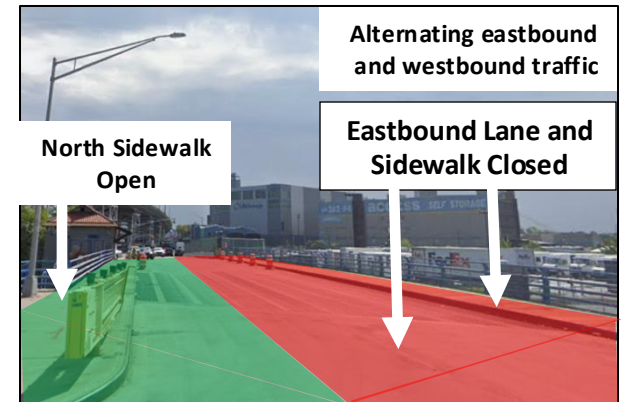
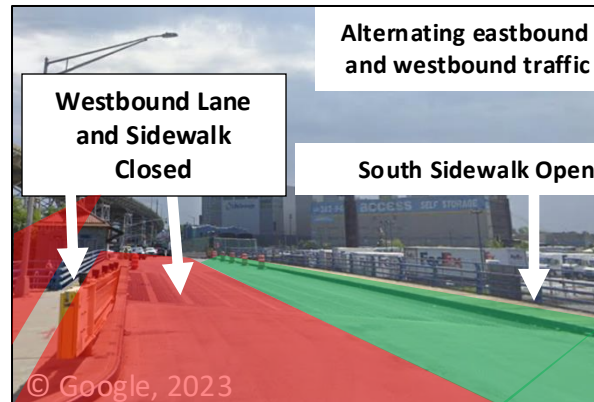


# Important Notice

The NYCDOT Division of Bridges will continue work on the **Borden Avenue Bridge over Dutch Kills** in Queens as a part of the lead paint removal and repainting project. **Beginning on Wednesday, March 26 during work hours**, Borden Avenue (between 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Review Avenue) will continue to be **reduced to one travel lane. An alternate one-way operation will be in effect, and flaggers will be present**. The sidewalk adjacent to the closed travel lane will also be closed. This operation will be in effect for approximately 6 weeks.

**Work Hours:** Monday through Friday: 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. & Saturday and Sunday: 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Motorists may choose to use Hunters Point Avenue as an alternate route.

The staging areas on the eastbound Borden Avenue bridge approaches are still in place; the travel lane and sidewalks continue to be reduced at all times at these locations.
