NYC DOT will implement safety and accessibility improvements on Queens Blvd. between 35th St. and 43rd St.:

- Construct concrete bus boarding islands, enabling bus riders to board and exit buses safely and to harden the existing protected bike lane
- Construct concrete pedestrian islands to provide safe pedestrian refuge space, harden the existing protected bike lane, and encourage slower, safer turns for drivers
- Update bus stop locations for the Q32 and Q60 buses to improve bus service on the corridor

Implementation begins Spring 2025
