## Blissville Bike Network Safety Improvements

**NYC DOT will implement safety improvements to the Blissville Bike Network, connecting cyclists to the Kosciuszko and Greenpoint Ave. bridges:**

- Add a two-way parking protected bike lane on Review Ave. and Laurel Hill Blvd. (Greenpoint Ave. and 56th Rd.)
- Upgrade bike lane on Van Dam St. (Starr Ave. to Greenpoint Ave.) from standard to protected.
- Add a protected contra-flow bike lane on Greenpoint Ave. (Review Ave. to Starr Ave.)
- Add a standard northbound bike lane on Review Ave. (Greenpoint Ave. to Borden Ave.)
- Add a standard southbound bike lane on Starr Ave. (Borden Ave. to Van Dam St.)

## Implementation begins Summer 2025
