### 69th St Station

#### Weekend Closure Starting March 21, 2026

Work will be underway at the 69<sup>th</sup> St station and will include street closures on 69<sup>th</sup> St. Please refer to the information below for details on impacts:

**Street Closure:** Weekend closures on March 21–22 and March 28–29, 2026

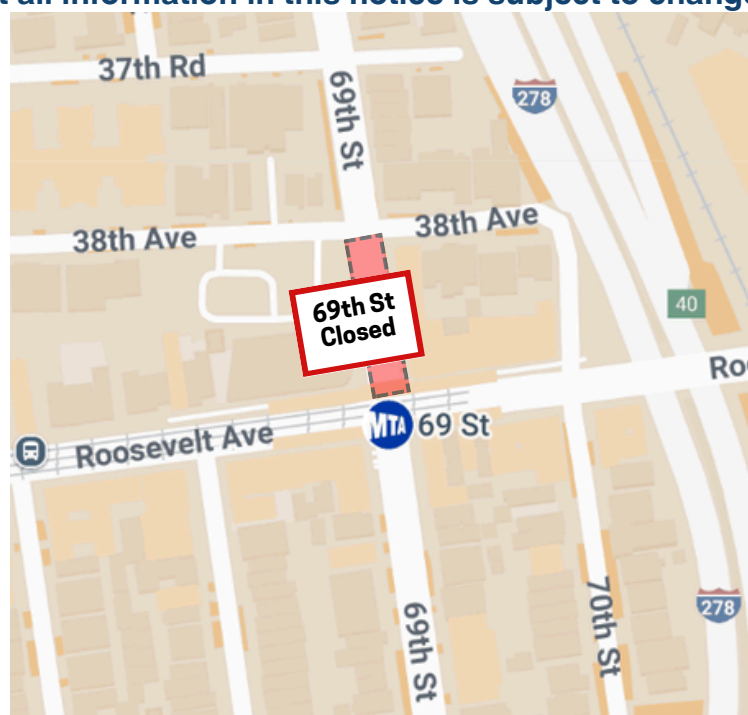
#### Details:

- 69th Street will be closed to traffic during work hours.
- Sidewalks will remain open at all times.
- Flaggers and signage will be in place to guide pedestrians and vehicles.

**Parking Restrictions:** Parking will be restricted along 69<sup>th</sup> St during closure hours. In addition, **NO PARKING** will be enforced directly under the full length of the elevated platform and an additional 50 feet beyond the end of the elevated platform. This restriction will remain until September 2026. There will be additional restrictions along Roosevelt Avenue.

**Bus service on routes Q32, Q47, Q49, and Q53 SBS will be unaffected and continue as normal**
