Slower, Safer Turns

NYC DOT will implement safety and accessibility improvements on Queens Blvd. between 35th St. and 43rd St.:

- Construct concrete bus boarding islands to allow for safe boarding and offboarding of passengers, to improve bus operations, and to improve cyclist safety on the corridor
- Construct concrete pedestrian islands to provide safe pedestrian refuge space, harden the existing Protected Bike Lane, and encourage slower, safer turns for drivers
- Coordinate with MTA's Queens Bus Network Redesign to update the locations of Q32 and Q60 bus stops for improved bus service on Queens Blvd.
- Construct a concrete curb extension at 39th St. to calm turns and shorten the crossing distance
- Convert turning lanes to parking lanes on 39th St. to calm traffic approaching Queens Blvd.
