Justin Elghanayan, President of Rockrose, said, "The Cove, a boutique, luxury rental building, will be the new centerpiece of the Court Square neighborhood, offering immediate access to all subways, restaurants, retail, and everything LIC has to offer. The Cove's affordable housing lottery offers a rare opportunity for moderate income renters to secure a luxury apartment in one NYC's most desirable neighborhoods."

The Cove, located at 43-12 Hunter Street, will contain studio, one-bedroom, and two-bedroom apartments, spread over 18 floors. All apartments feature hardwood floors, modern kitchens with stainless steel appliances and quartz countertops, and washers/dryers in every apartment. The Cove's full amenity package includes outdoor terraces and a roof deck with barbeque grills, a state-of the-art rooftop fitness center, a Cove Club Lounge featuring a game room, a Library Lounge for working from home, and a Sun Lounge with chaise loungers.

The Cove was designed by the award-winning design team of SLCE Architects, with interior design by Slade Architects.

The Cove's affordable housing lottery will be open through December 4, 2020. The building's market rate units are expected will be available later this year.
