**On Friday May 15**, the LIRR will be performing maintenance on a ballast retainer wall located on **Woodside Avenue, Woodside** to ensure its continued safety.

Work at **Woodside Avenue, Woodside** will include:

- Starting **Friday, May 15 11:00PM** and continuing until **Monday, May 18 4:00AM** work will take place
- **Work will require a street closure from the intersection of Woodside Ave & Barnett Ave south of the bridge to the intersection of Woodside & 38th Ave just north of the bridge**
- Nearby residents and businesses may experience temporary construction noise and illumination from lights onsite during evening work.

The LIRR will make every effort to minimize our construction presence.
