Department of Transportation provided the following update. They reported that the majority of the DOT projects are on hold and will be revisited once the City and the State reopen due to the COVID-19 Pandemic.

TRANSPORTATION ISSUES - Follow-up on DOT Issues:

Blissville

- Blissville Flagpole continue discussion. – next steps
- Previously approved Conversion of 37th Street to a one-way between Review Avenue and Bradley Avenue/Greenpoint Avenue. Please provide status of installation? Schools are now closed, can this work be done sooner?

Sunnyside

- Lighting outages in the Sunnyside Gardens area: 44th Street and 39th Avenue and 39th Avenue and 47th Street and 48th Avenue. DOT is continuing to conduct emergency repairs. Lighting outages in Sunnyside Gardens area 44th Street and 39th Avenue and 39th Avenue and 47th Street and 48th Avenue. Please advise when will be repaired?
 - 44th Street and 47th Avenue – foundation repair. Stop tag #227405 is now with Con Ed. (Case Number assigned to this is 4023246)
 - 39th Avenue and Woodside Avenue (53-17 39th Avenue). Foundation repair. The DOT checked with their lighting unit after the meeting and they gave a new update on this work order. Remains active with DOT Lighting. The contractor will come back and install the shaft with the luminaire. (Case number assigned to this is 4021617) Please provide an update.
 - Barnett Avenue and 43rd Street. Foundation Repair. Remains active with DOT Lighting (Case number assigned to this is 4101158) Please provide an update.
 - 44th Street and Barnett Avenue. Foundation Repair. Remains active with DOT Lighting (Case number 4645443) please provide an update.
 - 43-15 58th Street. Foundation Repair. Remains active with DOT Lighting (Case number 4021652) please provide an update.
