Important Notice

Beginning on January 20, 2024, NYCDOT will continue abrasive blasting operations on the Borden Avenue Bridge over Dutch Kills (between 27th Avenue and Review Avenue). The work began in early November 2023 and has been extended for approximately 30 days through February 20, 2024. As a result, Borden Avenue will be <u>reduced to one travel lane</u>, and a one-way operation will be in effect with flaggers alternating the flow of traffic (eastbound and westbound). This traffic pattern will be in place during the following hours:

- Monday through Friday: 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Saturday and Sunday: 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Motorists may use Hunters Point Avenue as an alternate route to bypass the construction zone.
