Mutual Aid and Food Pantries

We have a number of local organizations and food pantries that are helping so many in our community who are dealing with food insecurity. Among them are:

- Hour Children Food Pantry in Long Island City/Dutch Kills & has distribution three times a week. You can find information about them here.
- Bread of Life Food Pantry at the Center of Hope International serves primarily the Queensbridge area and is an important resource for those in need in and around Queensbridge with distribution several times a week.

- **The Mosaic Pantry** is giving food to many in the Sunnyside/Woodside area and has distributions on Monday and Thursday at 3:00pm.
- St. Raphael's Pantry at the Long Island City/Sunnyside border has the twice weekly distrubtions on Thursday and Saturday
- St. Theresa's Pantry in Sunnyside/Woodside every Tuesday from 4:00pm - 5:30pm
- <u>Corpus Christi Pantry</u> in Northern Woodside is open every Wednesday from 11am - 1pm
