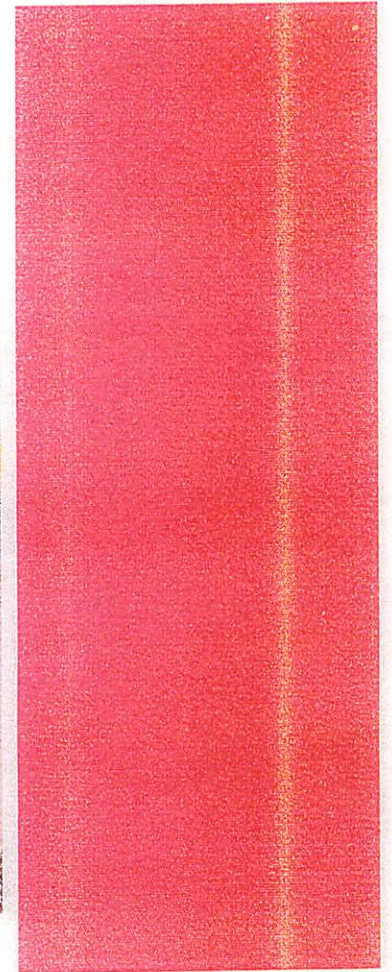


29th St Pollinator Pathway

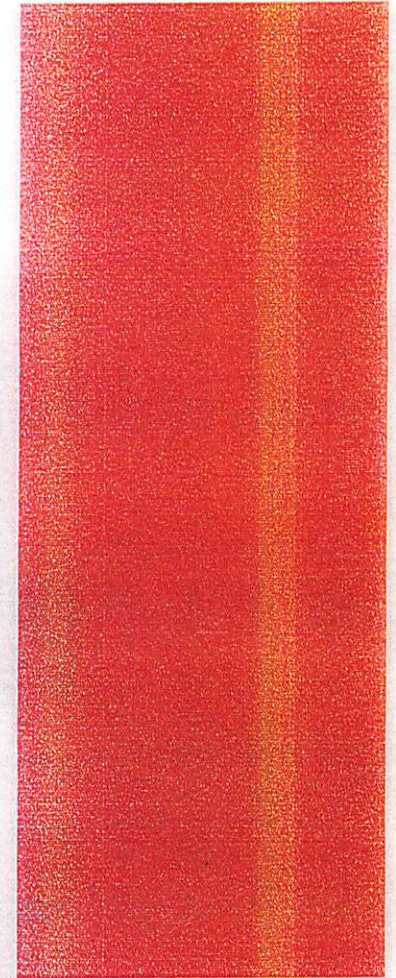
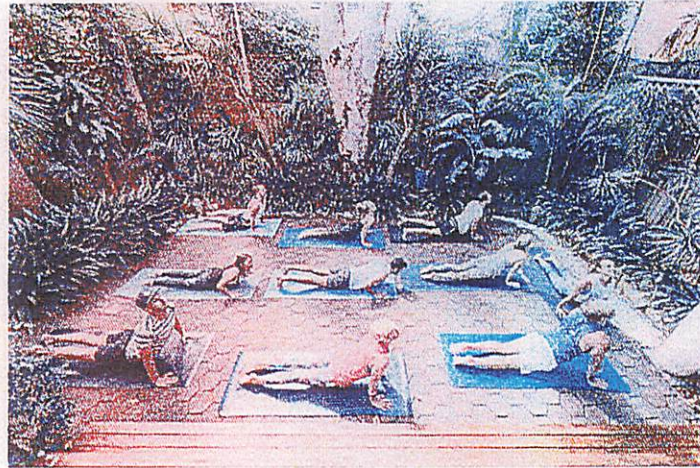
Provides vegetation for native pollinators

Community building



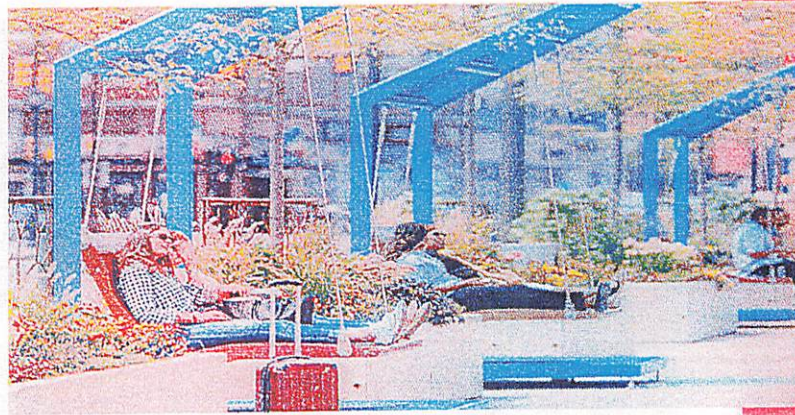
29th St North Open Space

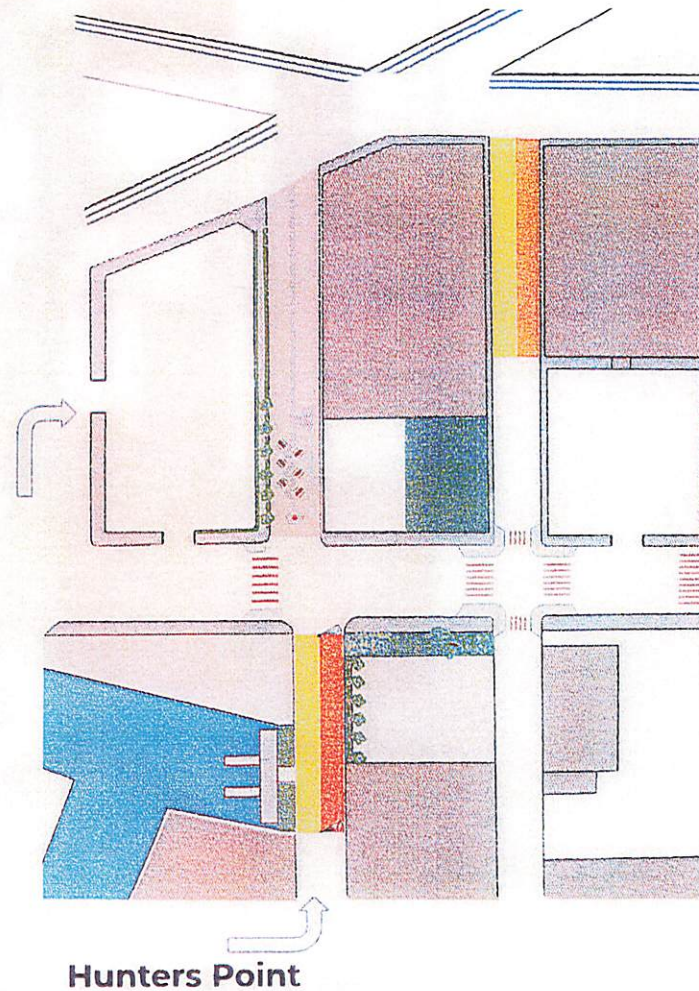


Bike lanes on Skillman and Thomson are part of the Long Island City Bike Neighborhood Plan



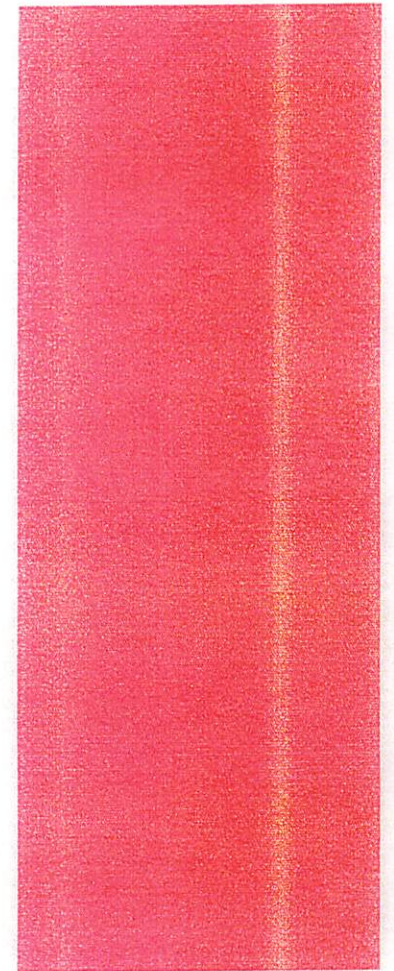
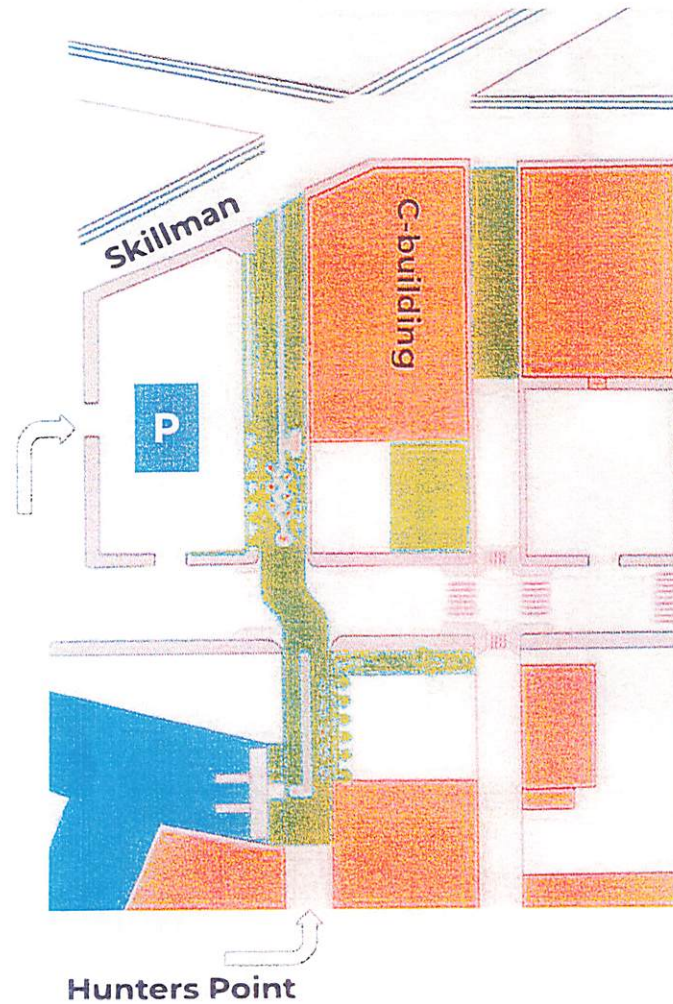
29th Street Green Space

of 29th Street

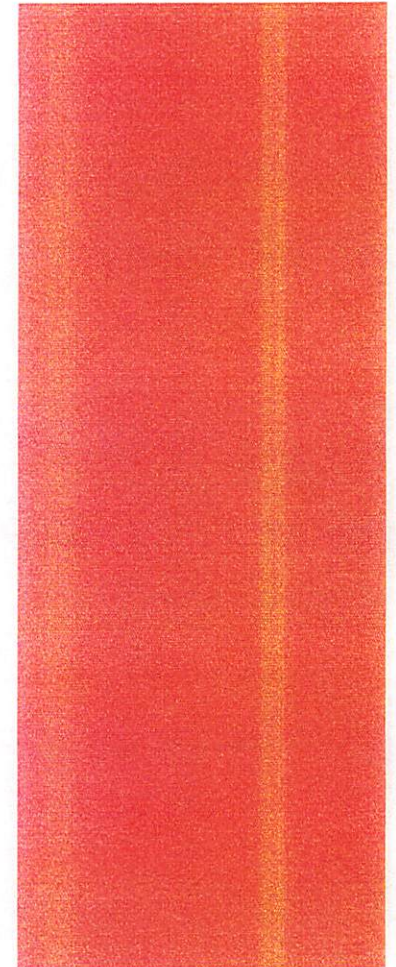
