## 34th Ave., Broadway to 69th St. Street Safety Improvements

Calm Traffic

Maintain Traffic Capacity

**NYC DOT will implement street safety improvements at 34th Ave., Broadway to 69th St.:**

- Install protected bike lanes on both sides of 34th Ave.
- Install pedestrian islands to shorten crossing distances and calm traffic.
- Install standard bike lanes on 59th St. and 60th St. between 34th Ave. and 39th Ave.

## Implementation begins Fall 2022
