DOT's Bikeshare Program is coming to our District

What is Citi Bike?

Citi Bike is the bike share system available in Manhattan, Brooklyn, Queens, and the Bronx. The system is run fitnough a public-private partnership between New York City and Lyft. Citi Bike is a station-based bike share system. Riders unlock bikes from one station and return and lock the bike at any other station in the system, making bike share ideal for short, one-way trips.

As part of the process, New York City Department of Transportation provides the opportunity for those who may not be able to a tend a public meeting to give feedback through a feedback portal where people can comment on where they would like to see Cit Bike stations, as well as locations not suitable for a station.

This process involves holding community planning workshops and meeting with Community Boards, elected officials, and community stakeholders to gather input.

Over the next few weeks, Queens Community Board 4 will be reviewing the plan as we actively seek public input in advance of our June 13th Full Board meeting.







FDNY means pride, respect and opportunity. The Fire Cadet Academy is designed to ensure that Cadets become familiar with the operations of the Fire Department and to provide leadership training. Cadets will receive significant classroom, field and fitness training over the course of the two (2) year program. Cadets will be required to attend the Fire Academy two (2) Saturdays per month to participate in classroom training, field training, and fitness conditioning.

Cadets will be assigned to work in major FDNY bureaus where they will receive hands-on training and learn how the bureaus relate to one another in order to provide optimal response to emergencies, as well as to enhance their ability to provide service in a number of capacities throughout the Agency. Cadets must be willing to commit to a minimum of 20 hours per week and can work up to 34 hours per week.

Cadets will earn \$15.67 per hour. Cadets who work more than 20 hours per week are eligible to receive health benefits.
