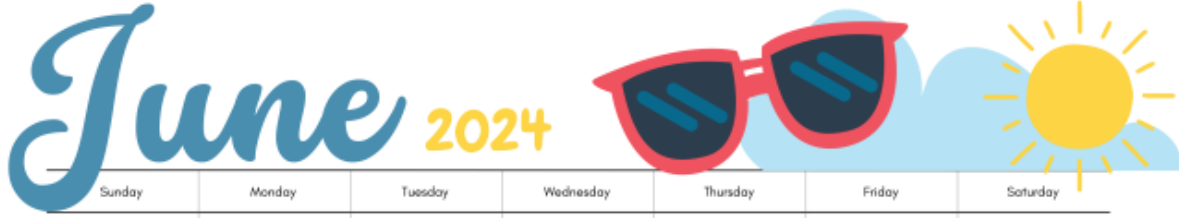
### June is here

The New York City Charter ("Charter") provides the structure of City government and key powers of City elected officials and agencies. The City Charter Revision Commission ("CRC") is empowered to review the entire Charter to ensure that City government works efficiently and remains responsive to all New Yorkers. The public is invited to testify about any matter of importance to City government.

## Guidelines

### Who can give input?

Any member of the public may testify, as long as they adhere to the three (3) minute time window allotted to them.

New Yorkers from any of the five boroughs may testify, no matter where the meeting is held.

Are you a group, organization, or institution that wants to testify? No problem! Just designate a single representative to testify.

### Didn't get to testify?

The CRC will attempt to accommodate everyone who wishes to speak, but if the time does not permit, we encourage you to utilize other opportunities to testify at subsequent public hearings or by submitting written testimony to [charterinfo@citycharter.nyc.gov](mailto:charterinfo@citycharter.nyc.gov)
