IMPORTANT REMINDER

Beginning **November 12, 2024**, all properties with 1-9 residential units will be required to use bins (55 gallons or less), with secure lids to set out trash. This rule also applies to any special-use building with DSNY collection—including City agencies, houses of worship, and nonprofits.

You can use a compliant bin (55 gallons or less with a secure lid) that you already have, but starting **June 2026**, you **MUST** use an **Official NYC Bin**.

NYC Official Bin

The NYC Bin is available for purchase at a significantly lower price than similar bins at retail stores, at www.bins.nyc or by calling 1-855-NYC-BINS.

Order your Official NYC Bins by October 1 to get guaranteed delivery by November 12!

DSNY will retrofit or replace hundreds of collection trucks by 2026, adding mechanical tipping arms compatible with the new bins. This upgrade will speed up collection and minimize the possibility of spills that occur with manual collection.

Recycling and Composting

NYC Bins are available to order for recycling and composting, although they are not required. Compost must be set out in bins (55 gallons or less) with secure lids. Curbside Composting is mandatory in Brooklyn and Queens and will expand to all five boroughs October 6.

About the New York City Department of Sanitation

The Department of Sanitation (DSNY) keeps New York City healthy, safe and clean by collecting, recycling and disposing of waste, cleaning streets and vacant lots, and clearing snow and ice. The Department operates 59 district garages and manages a fleet of more than 2,000 rear-loading collection trucks, 450 mechanical brooms and 705 salt spreaders. The Department clears litter, snow and ice from approximately 6,500 miles of City streets and removes debris from vacant lots as well as abandoned vehicles from City streets.

Curbside Composting

Curbside Composting service is now available to ALL NYC residents citywide.

Service is year-round every week, and collection is on your recycling day.

A quick reminder about the NYPD's Neighborhood Policing Program!



IMPORTANT PUBLIC HEARING INFORMATION BELOW

Please see the public hearing notice below regarding proposed permanent rules which amend New York City firearm licensing standards in light of the Supreme Court decision in *N.Y. State Rifle & Pistol Ass'n v. Bruen*, 142 S. Ct. 2111 (2022), and evolving Second Amendment jurisprudence. **The public hearing is virtual and scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Monday, November 25.** This notice will be published in the City Record on Friday, October 25.

In brief, these rules:

1. Create a procedure to allow individuals who do not reside in NYS to apply for licenses within NYC;
2. Clarify the procedures surrounding registering a handgun to a person's license; and
3. Amend the limitations to the quantity of handguns that may be registered to a

Concealed Carry license.

4. Makes minor corrections.

Additionally of note: A licensee may still only carry concealed one firearm at any given time.

New York City Police Department
Notice of Public Hearing and Opportunity to Comment on Proposed Rules

What are we proposing? The New York City Police Department (“NYPD”) is proposing amendments to title 38 of the rules on the City of New York in order to:

- establish a process by which individuals who do not reside in New York State, are not principally employed within New York City, and do not have their principal place of business in New York City can apply for a license to carry a firearm;
- amend and clarify the process for purchasing and adding firearms to an existing New York City firearms license; and
- amend the rules to correct typographical errors and modernize outdated references.

The portion of the rule that establishes a process by which individuals residing and working outside of New York State can apply for a license to carry a firearm is being proposed to make permanent changes that were adopted on an emergency basis and published in the City Record on October 23, 2024.

When and where is the hearing? NYPD will hold a virtual public hearing on the proposed rule. The public hearing will take place at 10:00am on November 25, 2024.

Enter your name when prompted and click the “**Join now**” button. If you don’t have computer audio or prefer to phone in for audio, select “**Phone audio**” under “**Other join options**” then click the “**Join now**” button. You will first be placed in a waiting status in the virtual lobby, then be admitted when the hearing begins. If you are using phone audio then follow the dial-in instructions when prompted.

If you have low bandwidth or inconsistent Internet connection, we suggest you use the Phone audio option for the hearing. This will reduce the possibility of dropped audio and stutters.


