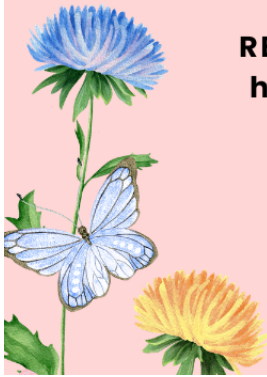

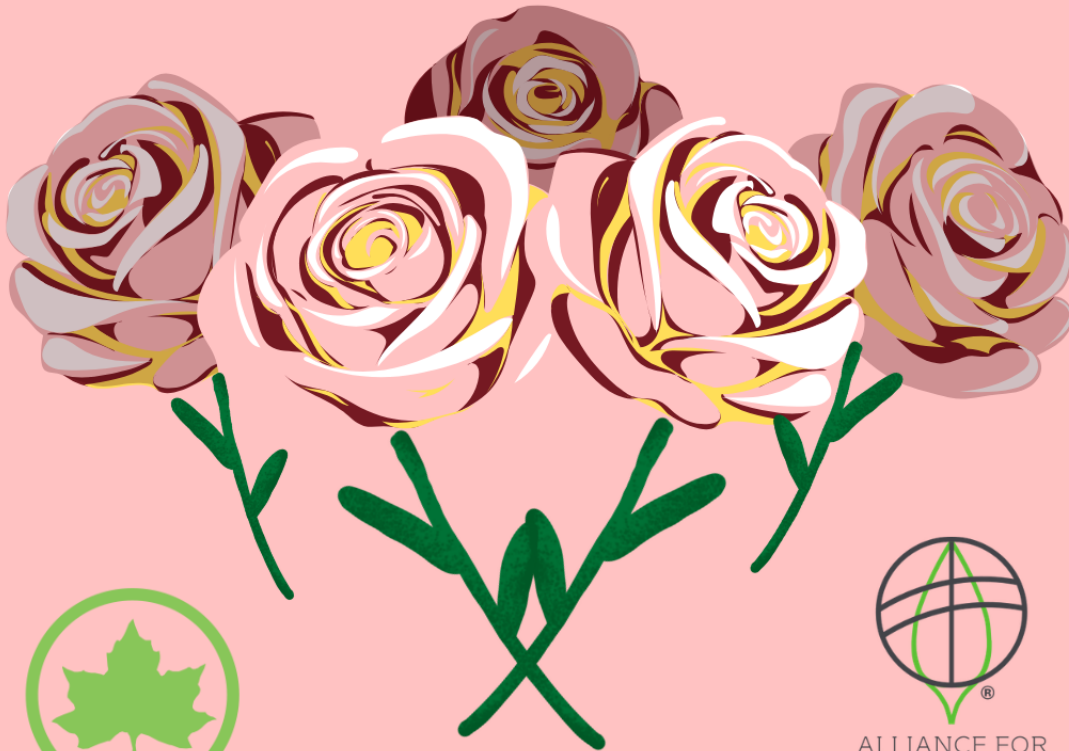

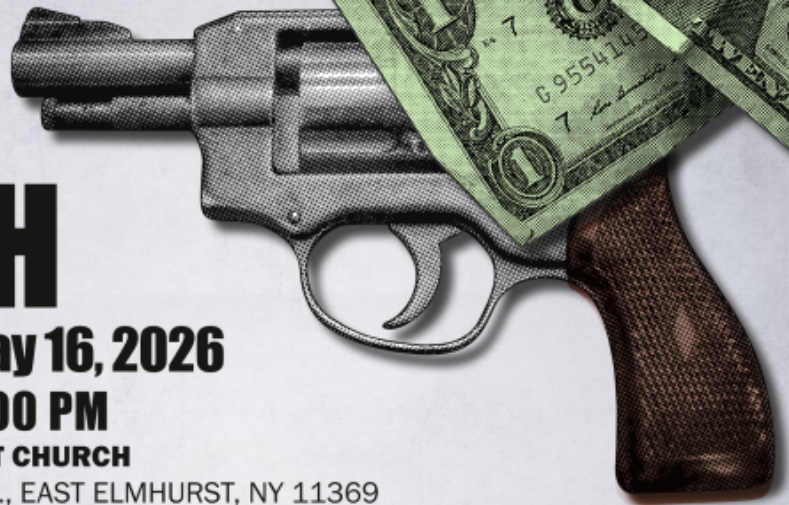

HOW DO I BRING A FIREARM TO THE DROP-OFF SITE?

Gun(s) must be placed in a plastic or paper bag, or in a shoe box.

CAN I TRANSPORT GUN(S) IN A CAR?

If transporting by car, gun(s) must be in the trunk.

HOW MANY GUNS CAN I SURRENDER?

You can surrender as many guns as you wish, but the payment limit is 2 ghost guns or 3 firearms per person.

WHEN DO I GET PAID?

Cash-card payment is on-site, after gun has been screened and deemed operable.

CAN I SURRENDER A RIFLE OR SHOTGUN?

Rifles and shotguns will be accepted for a \$75 cash card each.

IS THERE A PHONE NUMBER I CAN CALL FOR MORE INFORMATION?

Yes, you can call 311 for information regarding the program.

GUNS OWNED BY ACTIVE OR RETIRED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS OR LICENSED GUN DEALERS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
