Pilot New Curbside Regulations



Reduce Travel Lane Blockages

Improve Peak Hour Travel

NYC DOT will pilot curbside access restrictions on Roosevelt Ave. from Broadway to 90th St.:

- DOT will restrict curbside parking and loading on both sides of the street during weekday peak hours (7 - 10 a.m. and 4 - 7 p.m.)
- Regulations allow for expeditious pick-up and drop-off of passengers
- Regulations allow for deliveries to off-street loading docks
- NYPD will assign additional staff to enforce curb regulations
- DOT will monitor operations and reassess program after six-month pilot

Implementation starts in mid-March

NYC DOT pondrá a prueba restricciones de acceso a las aceras de Roosevelt Ave., desde Broadway hasta 90th St.:

- DOT restringirá el estacionamiento y la carga junto a las aceras, a ambos lados de la calle, durante las horas pico de los días de semana (de 7 a 10 a.m. y de 4 a 7 p.m.)
- Las regulaciones permitirán recoger y desmontar pasajeros de manera rápida
- Las regulaciones permitirán las entregas en las zonas de carga fuera de las calles
- NYPD asignará personal adicional para hacer cumplir las regulaciones de las aceras
- DOT controlará las operaciones y reevaluará el programa después de una prueba de seis meses

La implementación comenzará a mediados de marzo

Items To Bring To Your Free Tax Prep Session

To have your tax returns prepared at a VITA (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance) tax site, please bring the following information with you:

- Proof of identification - Government issued photo ID (State ID, Driver's License, or Passport)
- Social Security cards for you, your spouse and dependents or a Social Security number verification letter issued by the Social Security Administration
- An Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) assignment letter may be substituted for you, your spouse and your dependents if you do not have a Social Security number
- Proof of foreign status, if applying for an ITIN
- Birth dates for you, your spouse and dependents on the tax return
- Wage and earning statements (Form W-2, W-2G, 1099-R, 1099-Misc) from all employers
- Interest and dividend statements from banks (Forms 1099)
- A copy of last year's federal and state returns, if available
- Proof of bank account routing and account numbers for direct deposit such as a blank check
- To file taxes electronically on a married-filing-joint tax return, both spouses must be present to sign the required forms
- Total paid for daycare provider and the daycare provider's tax identifying number such as their Social Security number or business Employer Identification Number
- Forms 1095-A, B or C, Affordable Health Care Statements
- Copies of income transcripts from IRS and state, if applicable

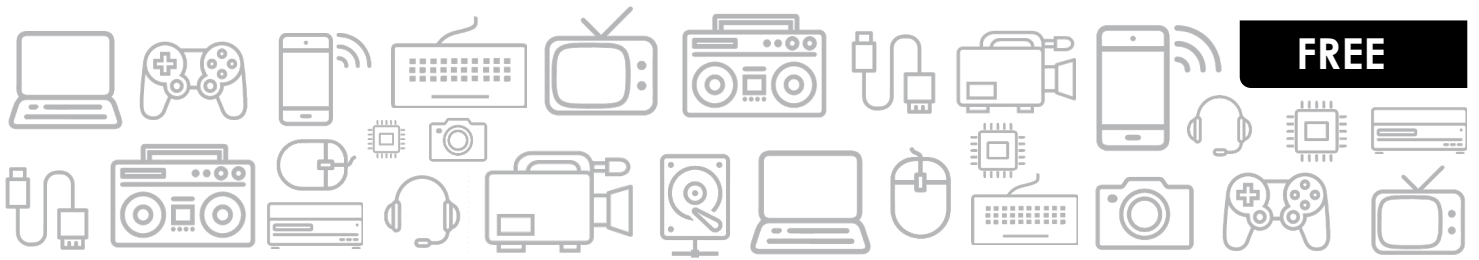

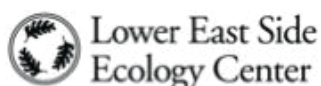

How To Package Materials for the Event

1. Look for items labeled DANGER, POISON, WARNING, or CAUTION.



2. Do not mix products.



3. Ensure products are labeled clearly.



4. Tightly seal and package all containers.



Tips: Syringes and lancets should be packaged in a “sharps” container or other leak-proof, puncture-resistant container, and clearly labeled. TVs or computer monitors with broken glass should be placed in separate sealed bags or boxes.

Only NYC residential waste will be accepted. No commercial vehicles allowed. Residents **MUST** provide proof of NYC residency (NYS driver's license, utility bill, etc.). For more information, visit nyc.gov/safedisposal.

If you can't make it to a SAFE Disposal Event, try these alternatives.

Appliances with CFC/Freon (refrigerators, air conditioners & dehumidifiers): Contact 311 to make an appointment for CFC removal, then recycle curbside. **Not accepted at SAFE Events.**

Automotive Batteries: Return to any service station or auto supply store that sells them, or bring to a DSNY Household Special Waste Drop-Off Site.

Batteries: Drop off rechargeable batteries at retailers that sell them. Bring any battery to a DSNY Household Special Waste Drop-Off Site.

Compact Fluorescent Bulbs (CFLs): Drop off at any Home Depot, Lowe's, or Ikea, or bring to a DSNY Household Special Waste Drop-Off Site.

Electronics: Drop off at Lower East Side Ecology Center e-waste events, Best Buy, Staples, Goodwill, Salvation Army, or the Gowanus E-Waste Warehouse, or bring to a DSNY Household Special Waste Drop-Off Site. Restrictions and fees may apply. Apartment buildings can sign up for eycleNYC. For more information, visit nyc.gov/electronics.

Household Appliances: Remove batteries and recycle curbside. **Not accepted at SAFE Events.**

Latex Paint: Dry out and discard paint as trash, recycle empty paint containers curbside, or bring latex paint to a DSNY Household Special Waste Drop-Off Site.

Mobile Phones: Drop off at wireless service providers or bring to a DSNY Household Special Waste Drop-Off Site.

Motor Oil: Bring to a service station with oil changes or to a DSNY Household Special Waste Drop-Off Site.

Syringes and Lancets: Drop off at any hospital or nursing home in New York State in a tightly sealed, clearly labeled, and puncture-resistant container.

Thermostats and Thermometers: Visit thermostat-recycle.org for locations, or bring to a DSNY Household Special Waste Drop-Off Site.

Tires: Bring back to businesses that sell them, bring to a DSNY Household Special Waste Drop-Off Site, or to any DSNY garage. **Not accepted at SAFE Events.**

Free Legal Assistance Available in Queens and Brooklyn

Catholic Migration Services, a non-profit organization associated with the Roman Catholic Diocese of Brooklyn, with offices in Queens and Brooklyn, has provided free legal advice and representation since 1971. Our legal services – which include assistance with matters involving immigration, housing and employment – are available to low-income residents of Queens and Brooklyn regardless of religion or citizenship.

Immigration Services

We provide a wide range of assistance to immigrants, including assistance with affirmative filings and removal defense. Immigration legal services are only available for clients residing in Brooklyn or Queens.

Affirmative Filings:

We provide legal assistance and representation in a wide range of affirmative applications for immigration relief, including, but not limited, to:

- Naturalization/citizenship
- Family reunification
- Employment authorization
- Special Immigrant Juvenile Status (SIJS)
- Political asylum
- Visas for victims of crimes or trafficking
- Violence Against Women Act (VAWA)
- Temporary Protected Status (TPS)

Removal Defense

The Immigration Legal Services Program provides free representation to some immigrants in deportation and removal proceedings.

To Get Help With Immigration Matters

Assistance for Tenants

We provide free advice and representation to Queens and Brooklyn tenants with housing problems and questions, such as:

- Needed repairs and essential services
- Eviction notices and threats
- Housing Court proceedings
- Help organizing tenant associations
- Leases and rent increases
- Succession rights
- Applications for SCRIE or DRIE
- Landlord threats or harassment

Assistance for Workers

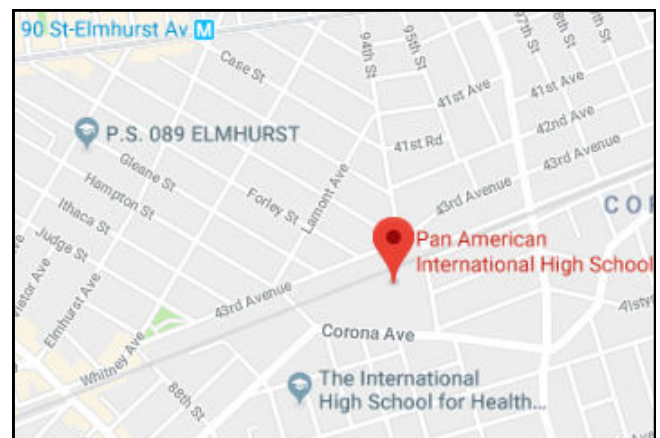

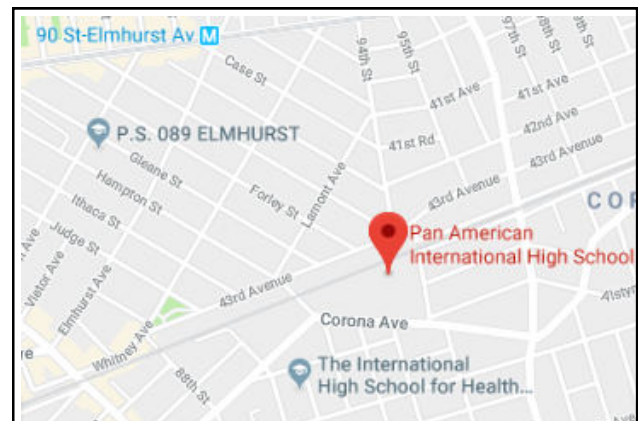

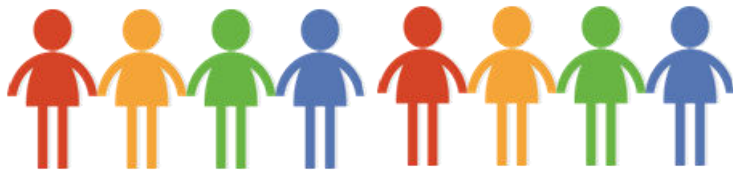
