

- STAR: homeowners with an annual income of \$500,000 or less.
- E-Star: seniors age 65 and over with annual incomes of \$86,000 or less.
- SCHE/DHE: seniors age 65 and over, disabled homeowners with annual incomes of \$58,399 or less.
- Veterans: who served in the US military during designated periods of conflict, their unmarried surviving spouse and Gold Star parents.
- Clergy: for active and retired members of the clergy and their unmarried surviving spouse. Must be NYS resident.







To file online: You must have your 2016 Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) or Self-Select PIN Number. If you cannot find this information on the return or do not have your 2016 tax return, call the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) at 1-800-908-9946 or visit irs.gov and search "Get Transcript" to request a Tax Return Transcript.

- □ Proof of health insurance coverage (Forms 1095-A, 1095-B, or 1095-C) or Health Insurance Exemption Certificate (if applicable) for you, your spouse, and your dependents
- Payment records for child care, including the provider's name, address, and Employer Identification Number, Taxpayer Identification Number, or Social Security number
- Records of cash and non-cash charitable contributions
