- Volunteers must commit to 1 weekend volunteer day (9:30-4:00) each week from March through the end of June 2017. Volunteers are also needed during public school spring recess (April 10-18).
- Participants must be 14 years old as of March 11th in order to apply. In addition to the application, ALL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS MUST HAVE A TEACHER SUBMIT A LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION.
