



Important Notice

In the early morning hours of TUESDAY, JUNE 6th, WEDNESDAY, JUNE 7th and THURSDAY, JUNE 8th the NYC Department of Transportation Division of Bridges will close the single eastbound lane of the Roosevelt Avenue Bridge between 126th Street and Janet Place from 12:01 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. Lanes on the bridge have already been reduced due to Stage 1 construction. As a result, only one lane of westbound traffic will be allowed during this period. Please see the back of this page for a detour map. The closure is necessary to perform bridge deck repairs and is contingent upon weather conditions.






