CEREMONY TO COMMEMORATE 100TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE DEATH OF PFC WILLIAM F. MOORE, CORONA NATIVE AND MARINE PRIVATE KILLED IN WORLD WAR I

PFC Moore was a Marine private killed in the battle of Belleau Woods during World War I. Moore was a graduate of PS 17, and grew up on the corner of 103rd Street and Corona Avenue. Moore enlisted in the Marine Corps in April of 1917 and was killed in 1918 while serving with the 47th Company, Fifth Marine Regiment at Belleau Wood in France, in one of the bloodiest engagements fought by the United States during the war.


