



- STAR: Homeowners with an annual income

- ESTAR: Seniors aged 65+ with an annual income of \$86,300 or less. - SCHE/DHE: Seniors aged 65+, or disabled
- rs with an annual income of \$58,399 or less. - Veterans: Who served in the U.S. military
- during designated periods of conflict, their unmarried surviving spouse, and Gold Star parents.
