PRESENTATION BY WAN LING HUNG, ALZHEIMERS ASSOCIATION

Wan Ling Hung spoke about Alzheimers and Dementia. She highlighted the following facts about the disease:

- As generations have less children, there are less caregivers for those affected with the disease
- There is currently no drug / treatment that can cure this disease
- Funds need to be raised for research to help find a cure
- African Americans and Latinos are among the highest at risk for developing the disease

- It is important for people to be educated about the disease and recognize its importance

Steve Goldberg, Chair of Planning & Zoning Committee reported that the Board received the following application:

BSA – SPECIAL ORDER CALENDAR APPLICATION
CAL. NO. 75-00-BZ – 60-69 WOODHAVEN BOULEVARD

To extend the term of the previously granted variance allowing the use of the building at the above subject premises for Commercial Use Group 6 Offices. This application also seeks to change the prior office use to another Use

Group 6 Office Use for Mercy Drive, Inc (MDI), A Not-For-Profit Agency that provides services to individuals with developmental disabilities.

Mr. Goldberg reported that this location has been used for commercial purposes for many years and there has never been any issues. It is currently used by Mercy Drive, Inc, a social services agency. It is an office location for central staff only (no aides, no patients, etc.)

Fredrick Becker was present to answer any questions that the board had.

The committee voted unanimously to approve this application. Motion to approve the application passed unanimously on a roll call vote.
