7) 146-45 22nd Avenue, Whitestone – BSA 172-15-BZ – Revised application for development of a 2-story two family dwelling with cellar on a vacant corner lot with a 25 ft. width, seeks waivers for following ZR sections to underlying R3A zoning and proposes a seven (7) ft. front yard along 22nd Ave. (less than required ten (10) ft. (ZR -23-45(a)); proposes 1800 sq. ft. floor area contrary to 1500 sq. ft. allowed (ZR 23-14(b)); and dwelling unit sizes of 900 sq. ft. for each dwelling, instead of one unit that must contain at least 925 sq. ft. leaving 575 sq. ft. for a second unit (ZR 23-23(b)). Proposal includes an accessory two-car garage in rear, which does not require a variance.
