5) **26-11 123<sup>RD</sup> ST., COLLEGE POINT – BSA #2020-9-BZ** THE APPLICANT IS SEEKING A VARIANCE BECAUSE OF PHYSICAL CONDITIONS OF THE ZONING LOT IN ORDER TO BRING A REASONABLE RETURN. THE SUBJECT WAS ALWAYS A NARROW 20 FT. WIDE PROPERTY THAT WAS DIVIDED IN HALF FROM 194.76 FEET TO 97.38 FEET IN 1966.
