Cannabis/Liquor License Committee Chair Michael Hannibal called the meeting to order at 7:31 p.m. This was followed by self-introductions of all Board Members and staff.

### Purpose:

**CB8 Staff:** 

The applicant, Cajun Seafood Hillside Inc. d/b/a Aloha Krab Cajun Seafood & Bar located at 204-13 Hillside Avenue in Hollis, is applying for a Liquor, Wine, Beer & Cider License and Temporary Retail Permit. Chairman Michael Hannibal asked the applicant to state their name for the record. Applicant Biaozhuo Chen and representative Sam Park.

## Michael Hannibal

Is the restaurant a full restaurant with a bar? Answer: [Biaozhuo Chen] – Yes.

### **Michael Hannibal**

**Do you have a certificate of occupancy?** *Answer: [Sam Park]* – We will email you the certificate of occupancy.

## Michael Hannibal

We would need the information on the Public Assembly Permit since the restaurant holds more than 75 people. *Answer:* [Sam Park] – The maximum occupancy is 94 people. We will not have seating for 94 people. The maximum seating would be 64 people.

## Michael Hannibal Your resturant will never reach the maximum for the Public Assembly?

Answer: [Sam Park] – No.

## <u>Michael Hannibal</u>

## What is your hours of operation?

Answer: [Biaozhuo Chen] – 7 days a week from 11 a.m. to 11 p.m.

## Michael Hannibal

## Will you be there onsite as the owner?

Answer: [Sam Park] – Yes. The owner will always be in the restaurant to oversee the people, and the kitchen.

## How will you check for ID to prevent underage drinking?

Answer [Biaozhuo Chen] – We will check the ID to make sure they are over the age. We did not buy the machine to check the ID yet.

## Michael Hannibal

Does your security have any type of State training or are you using the same security that is already established in the restaurant?

*Answer* [*Biaozhuo Chen*] – We are not using a security guard since the area is safe. The previous owner did not have a security guard.

## Michael Hannibal

What type of security measures are you putting in place to prevent unruly behavior or if someone drinks too much?

*Answer* [*Biaozhuo Chen*] – I will not let them drink too much. If they do not feel good, we would stop them from drinking.

*Answer:* [Sam Park] – If the bartender cannot handle the customer, they will speak with the owner. The owner will then call the police.

## Michael Hannibal

How do you intend to maintain cleanliness in front of the establishment, i.e. meaning smokers and people loitering? *Answer* [*Biaozhuo Chen*] - Staff will sweep outside, four to five times, per day and we will not have ashtrays outside the establishment.

### Michael Hannibal

**Do you have any cameras?** *Answer* [*Biaozhuo Chen*] – Yes.

## Michael Hannibal

How is it recording? Is it on a monthly basis? Answer [Biaozhuo Chen] – Yes. We hold it for about a month.

## Chairperson Hannibal opened the meeting for questions from the Board Members.

## Are the employees the same?

Answer [Biaozhuo Chen] – No. The employees changed, but the restaurant will remain the same.

## <u>Alan Ong</u>

I would like to suggest that your employees take the Alcohol Training Awareness Program (ATAP) training. *Answer* [*Biaozhuo Chen*] – Thank you.

<u>James Gallagher</u> When did you open? Answer [Biaozhuo Chen] – October 31, 2024.

<u>James Gallagher</u> Did you have another restaurant before that? *Answer* [*Biaozhuo Chen*] – Yes. It was at a different location.

## James Gallagher

## I am concerned about the security, especially if you have a wild party.

*Answer* [*Sam Park*] – If you need us to have a security guard, we can hire one for the weekend. Friday and Saturday. *Answer* [*Biaozhuo Chen*] – I think the community is very good.

Douglas Sherman

## What was your background before you got involved in this type of business?

Answer [Biaozhuo Chen] - I was a sushi chef for twenty years and I owned the business.

Douglas Sherman

Is this establishment primarily seafood? Answer [Biaozhuo Chen] – Yes.

Douglas Sherman Will you also be serving sushi? Answer [Biaozhuo Chen] – No. They will not allow us.

**Douglas Sherman** 

Is there a particular day when the fish is delivered? Is it delivered every day? *Answer* [*Biaozhuo Chen*] – Not every day. Whenever we ask for it, they deliver.

**Douglas Sherman** 

How will you split your time between this restaurant and the other restaurant? *Answer* [*Biaozhuo Chen*] – We sold it. The restaurant in Levittown was sold in May.

**Douglas Sherman This would be your primary business?** *Answer* [*Biaozhuo Chen*] – Yes.

Soleil Griffin Why did you switch ownership? Answer [Biaozhuo Chen] – It was a partnership, and no one was able to help her.

Soleil Griffin

Is there a possibility that she would come back and work for you? *Answer* [*Biaozhuo Chen*] – I wish. She helped us for two weeks then went back to China.

Soleil Griffin Is this the first franchise that you have ever worked for? *Answer* [Sam Park] – This business is individually owned. I know there are a lot of Aloha Krabs.

<u>Michael Hannibal</u> This is not attached to a national chain? Answer [Sam Park] – No.

<u>Howard Fried</u> On the application, you have recorded music that you play at the restaurant? *Answer* [*Biaozhuo Chen*] – Yes, from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m.

## **Howard Fried**

Have you had any problems with people complaining?

Answer [Biaozhuo Chen] – No problems.

## Soleil Griffin

You stated that you have new employees, what happened to the other staff?

Answer [Biaozhuo Chen] – I told them to stay; however, she had school and found a job that provided more hours.

## Michael Hannibal

Are the waitstaff students that work part-time because of school?

Answer [Biaozhuo Chen] – If they ask for part-time, we will work with them.

## **Howard Fried**

#### How many people are employed at the restaurant?

Answer [Biaozhuo Chen] – Six full-time and two part-time employees.

## **Howard Fried**

Do you have any plans in the immediate future - in the next year or so, to change the format or expand the restaurant?

Answer [Biaozhuo Chen] - No. It is good, we are not going to change.

### Michael Hannibal

Can I have a motion to accept the application for Cajun Seafood Hillside Inc. d/b/a Aloha Krab Cajun Seafood & Bar located at 204-13 Hillside Avenue in Hollis?

### James Gallagher

### Would it be as per the certificate of occupancy?

*Answer* [*Michael Hannibal*] – We have the old one. We have it on record that they have no plans to max it to the ninety percent. The seats are at seventy-five.

Chairperson Hannibal asked all those in favor to say aye.
