EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 17

January 3, 1995

AMENDMENT OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2, DATED JANUARY 1, 1994, RELATING TO DEPUTY MAYORS

By the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of New York, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. Section 1 of Executive Order No. 2, dated January 1, 1994, as such Order was amended by Executive Order No. 9, dated June 17, 1994, and Executive Order No. 16, dated December 27, 1994, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. There shall be four Deputy Mayors. One shall be designated the First Deputy Mayor, one shall be designated the Deputy Mayor for Education and Human Services, one shall be designated the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Community Relations, and one shall be designated the Deputy Mayor for Finance and Economic Development.

- \$2. The introductory paragraph of section 2 of Executive Order No. 2, dated January 1, 1994, as amended, is amended to read as follows:
 - §2. The First Deputy Mayor shall:
- §3. Section 3 of Executive Order No. 2, dated January 1, 1994, as amended, is amended to read as follows:
- The First Depucy Mayor is hereby delegated the authority to perform all functions, powers or duties of the Mayor which the Mayor is authorized to delegate, in the event that the

Mayor is unable to perform such functions, powers or duties for a reason specified in subdivision a of section 10 of the New York City Charter.

- \$4. Paragraph c of section 4 of Executive Order No. 2, dated January 1, 1994, as amended, is amended to read as follows:
- c. Work with the First Deputy Mayor, in coordination with the Office of Management and Budget and the Office of Operations, to ensure the implementation of Mayoral policies regarding health and human services.
- \$5. All references to the Deputy Mayor for Operations in any other executive order or directive shall hereafter be deemed to refer to the First Deputy Mayor designated pursuant to this Order.
 - \$6. This Order shall take effect immediately.
