Job Description:

The Workforce Development Corporation is seeking a Data Analyst to work with a variety of stakeholders within the NYC Tech Talent Pipeline industry partnership. Responsibilities will include conducting and presenting analysis of how agency investments are performing against critical indicators of impact. Among the primary focal points of this work will be refining critical questions related to the results of training, education, recruitment, and capacity building initiatives designed to prepare and connect New Yorkers to tech jobs. It is expected that the analysis produced will be used to inform internal and external partners on the collective impact of investments and how best to sustain interventions that have proven successful.
