Today's hearing concerns a proposed amendment to the rules governing the MWBE program. The full text of the rule proposal and a statement of the basis and purpose were published in The City Record on March 28, 2023, and on the New York City Rules' website.

The proposed rules were certified by the New York City Law Department and the New York City Mayor's Office of

Operations.

By way of background, the City's

MWBE Goals Program, codified in Chapter

56 of the Charter and Section 6-129 of

the Administrative Code, establishes

goals for participation by

minority-owned business enterprises,

women-owned business enterprises, and

emerging business entities as

contractors and subcontractors in

procurements for construction, standard

services, goods valued under one million

dollars, and professional services.

Charter Section 1304 also requires the Commissioner of SBS to establish and operate, on behalf of the City, a centralized program for the certification of MBEs, WBEs, and EBEs for the purpose of establishing their eligibility for participation in the program.

This proposed rule would add a new subdivision (g) to Section 11-22 of Chapter 66 of the Rules, allowing business enterprises to remain eligible

for certification as MWBEs in cases where the minority or woman owner or owners transfer their shares to a trust for estate planning purposes. The rule outlines factors for the Commissioner to consider in determining whether certification is in the interest of the program.

At this time, we will open the floor to give an opportunity to members of the public to testify.
