# **PUBLIC SESSION**

Ms. Kelly Vilar gave an update from the Cromwell Coalition.

Mr. Jacob Bari from Level Solar spoke about purchasing solar energy.

Ms. Susan Master is working on opening a Young Woman's Leadership Academy in the north shore of Staten Island.

Ms. Priscilla Marco thanked Councilwoman Rose, the Board and the School Construction Authority for advancing the new school proposed at 357 Targee Street.

Mr. Fred Maley, Director of External Affairs, School Construction Authority gave an update on the Curtis H.S. new gym which should completed and in use in September 2017. It was noted that an adjoining homeowner of the field has used the material of the portion of the stone wall that had to be taken down on his property.

Mr. Maley spoke of the new P.S. 68 located at 1625 Forest Avenue which is a primary school will be starting Pre-K through 2 and grow to  $5^{th}$  grade.

Further updates were given for the Harbor Middle School a feasibility study is being done for possibly locating the school at Ft. Wadsworth.

Lastly, Mr. Maley stated there will be a Public Hearing for a new school at 357 Targee Street on November 17, 2016 – 7:00 P.M. at the Central Family Life Center, 59 Wright Street. The property is the old Victory Van Lines. The building would be demolished and a new primary school would be built.
