The following application was heard:

Board of Standards & Appeals Application No. 24-17-BZ - Reinstate variance for the gasoline service station and accessory uses which was granted under cal. # 960-58-BZ at 1400 Bay Street.

The variance expired in August of 2005. The original variance was approved in 1951 and was applied for every 10 years as it expired.

There has been change in ownership a few times. The Board of Standards and Appeals does not notify the applicant if the variance has lapsed. Power Test Realty Company Limited Partnership is the owner of and leases it. They are the company asking for the variance.

Mr. Guzzo stated he is ineligible to vote. The neighborhood does not have any attended gas stations. As stated by the applicant's representative it is needed.
