OFFICERS' REPORTS

<u>FIRST VICE-CHAIRMAN, ANTONY COSENTINO</u> — A Budget Public Hearing for Fiscal Year 2017 was held on October 4, 2016 — the following capital and expense items were discussed and reviewed and voted on unanimously to submit by the Budget Committee-

Create a new, or renovate or upgrade an existing public library - NYPL

- Build a Rosebank Library at the former Walgreens site at 570 Tompkins Avenue
- Renovate with ADA compliance the Port Richmond, St. George, West New Brighton and Westerleigh libraries.

Provide a new or expand an existing high school - DOE

- Build a new High School at Homeport.
- High Schools are beyond capacity Availability at Old SI Hospital at 101 Castleton Ave.
- High School in Concord, between Bay St. and the SIE and between Broad St. and Jones's Woods Park.

Renovate or upgrade an elementary school - DOE

- Build a gym in PS21.
- Purchase Immaculate Conception School for use as a UPK-12.
- The District is under lacking in capacity. Availability at Old SI Hospital at 101 Castleton Ave.

Provide a new or expand an existing middle/intermediate school - DOE

- Schools overcapacity, need relief. Availability at Old Staten Island Hospital at 101 Castleton Avenue.
- Build a middle school in the Arlington, Mariners Harbor Area.

Increase resources for other crime prevention programs - NYPD

- Purchase Argus Cameras for 120 & 121 Precincts.

Provide a new NYPD facility, such as a new Precinct House or Sub-Precinct - NYPD

 With the proposed Bay Street Corridor Affordable Housing rezoning, coupled with the new North Shore residential and commercial redevelopment, the current 120th is no longer adequate for the personnel, equipment & vehicles needed to keep the public safe.

Provide new facilities such as a firehouse or EMS station - FD

- The population has burgeoned and response times have risen making this new facility in the area between Hannah St. & Vanderbilt Ave, a matter of extreme public safety importance.

Renovate or upgrade an existing cultural facility – DCA

- Renovate Snug Harbor Veterans' Memorial Hall
- Repair the Snug Harbor Dock

Invest in piers or other capital projects to improve access to the Waterfront - EDC

 The New York Container Port infrastructure is in need of better truck access and new pier and expansion of the site.

Build or expand incubator or affordable work or research lab spaces - EDC

- This has proven successful in Stapleton and should be expanded to St. George & Rosebank.

Make Infrastructure investments that will support growth in local Business Districts – EDC

- Purchase and repair the esplanade from Triangle Equities to Hannah St. (Get update)
- The infrastructure from the NY Wheel to the Navy Pier must be upgraded to allow for better traffic control, better drainage control and better downtown connectivity.

Improve streetscapes in Business Districts to attract/encourage commercial activity, e.g., lighting, sidewalk improvements – EDC

Study the required infrastructure needed to develop the North Shore Greenway Trail & Bikeway.

Provide more housing for medium income households - DCP

- The corridor from Snug Harbor to Vanderbilt Ave. needs to be zoned C4-2 to permit affordable housing, including sites affordable for seniors.

Other sewer maintenance requests - DEP

- Install catch basins on Walker Street between Port Richmond Ave. to Van Pelt Ave. (updated)
- Install catch basins on Park Ave. between Richmond Terrace and Castleton Ave.
- Install catch basins on Heberton Ave. between Castleton Ave. and Richmond Terrace.

Build new, expand or repair storm sewers - DEP

Address Traffic Congestion - DOT

Install smart lights, sequential signals and turning lanes at major traffic choke points.

Upgrade or provide new Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Lanes

Routes isolated from traffic congestion are needed to get folks to work in a timely manner.

Other park facilities and access requests - DPR

- Provide a baseline \$100 million budget for Parks

Reconstruct or upgrade a park or playground - DPR

- Provide electrical service in Heritage Park
- Update Mariners Harbor Park and buy adjacent property
- Build a Soccer field block 487 lot 100 by Lyons Pool. New

Provide new or expanded parks facility, e.g. recreation center - DPR

- Cromwell Center needs to be rebuilt above Lyons Pool thus remaining central to the district and including a year round aquatic facility.
- Purchase land along Richmond Terrace to become part of Faber Park
- Provide \$16 Million to finalize Goodhue acquisition
- Place the office for Fresh Kills Park in Village Hall DPR Expense

Repair or upgrade subway stations or other transit infrastructure - SIRTOA

 The Stapleton station needs to be made safe to accommodate the development of the Navy Pier Project.

Study land use and zoning to better match current use or future neighborhood needs - DCP

The area from Snug Harbor to Vanderbilt Ave. needs to be zoned from M to C4-2 to allow for affordable housing and the area from Fort Wadsworth to Vanderbilt Ave. needs to be zoned to reflect the actual land uses in various districts contained within. Moreover, DCP should provide each CB with a dedicated planner and the personnel allocation for planners on SI be substantially increased.

Assign more teaching staff – Expense – DOE – Expense

- Provide art teachers in every school
- Add music teachers in every school

Create or promote programs for Education and awareness on nutrition, physical activity, etc. -

Create competitive sports' opportunities for middle and high school youth.

Provide more community board staff – DCP – Expense

 The Board needs a land use planner to keep up with zoning actions and to create zoning actions based on district needs.

Other housing support requests – HPD – Expense

Provide energy-saving grants to homeowners.

Support nonprofit cultural organizations- DCA - Expense

- Fund cultural organizations with budgets under \$25,000 and cultural business for at least five years with a minimum of \$25,000 each.

Provide a new bus service or Select Bus Service - TA - Expense

SBS is required to modernize mass transit in the district.

Expand Homelessness Prevention Programs - DOA - Expense

- Staten Island has one service provider and funding does not allow enough resource allocation to preventing homelessness only servicing the currently homeless.

Provide Additional senior center staffing - DOA - Expense

- Provide an additional 20% staffing at all senior centers.

Other education programs requests - DPE - Expense

- Fund visual arts and performance programming.
- Fund youth leadership programs.
- Provide environmental educational programming offered by the Northshore Waterfront Conservancy for disadvantaged young people.

Provide more firefighters or EMS workers - FD - Expense

- Provide higher staffing ratios to the houses that cover the NY Wheel, Empire Outlets, Lighthouse Pointe and Homeport.

Support Merchant Organizing - SBS - Expense

- Fund the Victory Boulevard Merchants' Association
- Fund the North Shore Merchants' Association
- Jersey Street Merchants' Association

Provide or expand district marketing, branding & promotion – SBS – Expense

- Expand service and funding for the West New Brighton LDC/BID/Business Outreach Center.
- Expand the funding and scope of services for the Northfield LDC.
- Jersey Street Merchants Association

Create or promote programs to de-stigmatize mental health problems and encourage treatment – DOMH – Expense

 Create programs to provide community education regarding the mental and physical health issues of transgendered youth.

Provide, Expand, or Enhance preventive services - ACS - Expense

- Provide sufficient funding for youth development and delinquency prevention programs.

Expand Programs for housing inspections to correct code violations - HPD - Expense

Add enforcement and plan examination staff specific to Staten Island.

Conduct traffic or parking studies - DOT

- Study the possibility of making Bay Street one-way from Hylan Blvd. to St. George.

Other traffic improvements requests - DOT

Create a turning lane on Martlings Avenue onto Manor Road acquiring land where needed.

In addition it was decided that the Steering Committee would set up 2 meetings one with the Commissioner of DOT and the other with the Commissioner of the Parks Department to discuss the budget requests after the area committee reviews each request in their area at the next area committee meeting.

The Board will write a letter to DCAS Commissioner requesting that all City buildings be equipped with Argus Cameras.

- Build a storm sewer on North Ave. between Livermore Ave. and dead end.

 The current District 1 site is in a sensitive residential and developing community and needs to be moved to Fresh Kills built at the same time as a new District 3 garage thus leaving the old District 3 garage to be used as a borough maintenance facility.

Improve traffic and pedestrian safety, including traffic calming- DOT

- On Targee St. between Osgood and Laurel Avenues.
- Rebuild and widen sidewalks along Richmond Terrace between Bank St. and Pelton Ave.

Repair or provide new street lights - DOT

- Upgrade lighting on Van Duzer St. between Broad St. & Hannah St.
- Install street lights at Edgewater St. and Hylan Blvd.
- Increase street lighting on Vanderbilt Ave.
- Upgrade lighting on Targee Street between Vanderbilt Ave. and Broad St.
- Upgrade lighting on Jersey Street. Benziger to Jersey and on corner of Brighton and Jersey with Argus Cameras – Updated
- Upgrade lighting on Canal Street.

Other transportation infrastructure requests – DOT

- Purchase Augustinian property from Howard Ave. to the service road to build a dedicated turn lane.

Repair or construct new sidewalks, curbs, medians, pedestrian ramps or bus pads - DOT

- Repair curbs on Colonial Court between Broadway and dead end.

Upgrade or create new plazas - DOT

 Upgrade and improve the "kiss and ride" plaza at the St. George Ferry improving pedestrian and bicycle access to the Lighthouse Museum site, including signage and lighting upgrades in the improvements.

Reconstruct Streets - DOT

- Reconstruct Dixon & Lake Avenues
- Reconstruct Richmond Terrace with a concrete subsurface between Nicholas Ave. & Broadway.
