**COMMUNITY BOARD #1 VIRTUAL AND IN PERSON LAND USE PUBLIC HEARING**  
**OCTOBER 7, 2020 – 6:30 P.M.**

Land Use Chairman Vincent Accornero called the Public Hearing to order at 6:37 P.M.

There were 2 items on the agenda:

1. Department of City Planning Application No. N 210021 ZAR submitted to authorize development on a steep slope to facilitate the development of two two-family detached homes located on Chester Place in the Special Hillside Preservation District.

Mr. Phil Rampulla presented the application on behalf of James Prendamano. Plans and diagrams were shown. The vacant lot is approximately 11,221 s.f and has not previously been developed. The property is located in an R3-2 District. Six parking spaces will be provided and there is an existing retaining wall in the rear of the property and fence. Drywells will be installed.

Non-Board Land Use Member Phil Farinacci asked that the rules be suspended, and we make a motion and vote on the Chester Place application.

Motion made and seconded to approve as submitted. Roll call vote taken, vote passed 10-0-0.

2. Board of Standards and Appeals Application Nos. 234-14-BZ and 225-14-A – each application seeks to permit the construction of one one-family home on 10 and 12 Jasmine Way off of 1534 Victory Blvd.

Ms. Elyse Foladare from the office of Eric Palatnik P.C. office showed plans and diagrams. There is an existing medical building fronting Victory Blvd. and one-family home on the property. It is proposed to demolish the one-family home. Jasmine Way would be a private driveway – it is not a private street since there is only going to be 2 homes on the property.

Ms. Maryanne McGowan had concerns how this is one zoning lot with 3 tax lots, what is to preclude the homes becoming some type of medical offices creating more traffic, the 18-foot curb cut. Ms. McGowan when this was previously brought before Community Board #1 Mr. Palatnik told her that a wall would be put for the neighbor who has a deaf child to insure if an accident the car would not go through the neighbor's yard and that garbage refuge would be placed in the front corner, therefore, the garbage trucks that come in the middle of the night do not have to back down the driveway.

Ms. Foladare mentioned to Ms. McGowan that she would speak to Mr. Palatnik about the wall in the back. The plans show the garbage pick would still be in the rear. The zoning lot was split into tax lots, that is what the law requires as is the 18-foot curb cut.

Mr. Phil Farinacci made a motion to approve both applications with a stipulation that a single-family deed restriction and single-family use declaration be included. Motion seconded.

**Roll call vote taken, vote passed 6-4-0.**
