Health Equity and Access to Care (HEAC) in NYC Focus Group Project - the CUNY School of Public Health is partnering with the NYC Department of Health to learn about people's healthcare experiences and recommendations for improvement.

The NYC DOHMH (Department of Health and Mental Hygiene) conducted an analysis that revealed significant differences in New Yorker's use of hospital services:

- *People of color* and those *with no or public health insurance* were more likely to use *public*/safety-net hospitals
- People wo identified as *white and/or with private health insurance* were more likely to use *private* hospitals.

This data was collected from NYS SPARCS (Statewide Planning And Research Cooperative System.) SPARCS data are limited to what hospital collect/report, which is of a quantitative nature. While the data explains "what" is happening, it cannot explain "why" it's happening. This is the impetus for the Focus Group Project.

They are reaching out to many community based organizations including DOHMH grantees, Community Boards, Borough Presidents' offices, DOE Parent Coordinators, Wellness Councils, CUNY School of Public Health, In-person city-wide events. They welcome any and all suggestions from the public on how they can increase their scope.
