### Old Business

Chairman Morano has prepared a letter in opposition to the proposal to charge city residents \$30/year for a parking permit that would allow them to park their cars on the city street, with the proceeds going to the MTA.

"The Senate advances language authorizing New York City to establish a parking permit system for residential neighborhoods in the City. Revenues from the parking permit system will be dedicated to the MTA." The Bill is presently in the City Council (Intro 0899-2023) but is not citywide.

*Whereas*, the Traffic & Transportation Committee is against any proposal to charge residents a fee to park their cars on the street, and

*Whereas*, a Motion was put forth to inform all elected officials on Staten Island, as well as the Mayor of NYC of same.
