**Living Breakwaters Construction Update** – Living Breakwaters is a state-of-the-art blue-green infrastructure project designed to reduce risk to Tottenville's shoreline, enhance harbor ecosystems, and support education and stewardship across Staten Island and Raritan Bay.

- 6 of the 8 breakwaters (A thru F) are complete.
- Shoreline restoration is complete (Manhattan St. to Loretto St.)
- G & H are nearing completion
- The Breakwaters construction project will be completed this fall.
