## <u>Agenda</u>

**The New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT**) is progressing a capital project to rehabilitate the northbound and southbound bridge structures carrying the West Shore Expressway over Woodrow Road (Project PIN X096.34). The scope of this project includes the replacement of the bridge deck and approaches, structural repairs as well as replacement of various elements including barriers, lighting and signage.

## **Project Purpose and Objectives**

- Improve the overall condition of the bridge structures
- **Preserve** and **prolong** the service life of the bridge structures
- **Reduce** the need for future maintenance repairs on the bridge structures for many years, including associated lane closures necessary to perform maintenance or emergency repairs

- **Reduce** the life cycle maintenance costs for the bridge structures
- Enhance the safety of the traveling public
