Grand Oaks Country Club Concessions Renovation and Expansion –

Joy Guttierrez, NYC Parks, Deputy Director of Concession Architecture presented plans for the renovation and expansion of the Grand Oaks Country Club. Mr. Joseph Tranchina is a licensed Concessionaire with the City of New York. He was awarded a new license agreement with a 19-year term. As part of the license agreement, Mr. Tranchina will undertake capital improvements on behalf of the city.

- Newly designed entrance with new brick wall, lampposts with planters, shrubbery
- New East and South elevations
- Outdoor Pergola
- New expanded second level with new roof and terrace
- New entry extension with metal roof and Mansford roof
- Total capacity increases by 120 ppl
