4. A motion was made to approve the base station license application recommendations. The motion passed unanimously.

5. Item 5 on the Agenda, proposing amendments to the rules that 1) require the Technology System Providers to reimburse the Driver Incentive TIF/SHLIF payment directly to the driver 2) permit medallion owners to place a used Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle into service while eliminating the vehicle retirement requirement for Wheelchair Accessible Vehicles 3) extend the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) vehicle specification standards, which currently apply to taxicabs, to accessible For-Hire Vehicles, and 4) require licensed drivers re-take Passenger Assistance and Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle On-Demand training courses under certain circumstances. The rule was presented for a vote, and the rule passed by a unanimous vote.
